COMMISSIONING OF NEW ALTAR SERVERS

The following text may be adapted for use during the celebration of Sunday Eucharist where new Altar Servers are commissioned. The commissioning may take place after the homily, before the Profession of Faith.

INTRODUCTION



'In the body of Christ there exists a wonderful variety of gifts, which are especially evident when we gather around the altar to worship God. By virtue of our baptism in Christ some are called to serve the liturgical assembly: our altar servers help the sacristans prepare for Mass and assist the priest and assembly during the celebration of Eucharist. Today we commission our new Altar Servers in our parish.'

Priest: Inspired by the self-giving of Jesus Christ, Himself, I promise to fulfil my duties and responsibilities as an Altar Server with the help of Mary, Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament, together with the entire Christian community and fellow Altar Servers.

Priest: As Servers, you are called to assist the priest and deacons at God's Altar on behalf of all our parish community. You are to be thoughtful, prayerful and attentive as you serve, knowing that the whole community relies upon you. Know that you touch sacred things and that you are very closer to Jesus who came not to be served but to serve. Grow to be more like Him, serving with a generous heart, a willing readiness and an alert mind. Pray the Liturgy that you serve and listen carefully to God's Word.

In this way you are to deepen your love for our God, our Church and this community. Know that the Holy Spirit is with you to guide you. Know also that you can rely on the prayer, support and affection of our parish family, who will encourage you in your journey of faith and service.

The Parish Priest may wish to present the newly commissioned Altar Servers with a cross/crucifix (as local custom dictates) to wear over their cassock/alb when serving Mass.

The Mass continues with the Profession of Faith and Prayers of the Faithful. The new Altar Servers begin serving with the Offertory and Presentation of the Gifts.

SAMPLE PRAYERS OF THE FAITHFUL

Some of the following sample Prayers of the Faithful may be included in the general intercessions of the Mass at which they are commissioned.

We pray for our newly commissioned Altar Servers: may they serve the Lord with enthusiasm, attentive prayerfulness, and a desire to grow in holiness. **Lord, hear us.**

We pray for the continued faithfulness of our existing servers: may they inspire and encourage the younger servers, lead by good example, and deepen their relationship with the Lord. **Lord, hear us.**

We pray for all Altar Servers: open their mouth to praise you in word and song, their ears to hear your Word, their hands to do your work well, and the desire to worship and serve you in the assembly. **Lord, hear us.**

We pray for parents: may they affirm the decision of their children to respond to the Lord's call to service in their parish-community. **Lord, hear us.**

We pray for those responsible with training, encouraging, and overseeing Altar Servers in our Parish. We thank God for their dedicated service and may they inspire our Servers by their prayerful example. **Lord, hear us.**

We pray for our community: may we encourage and nurture the involvement of the young in our parish. Instil confidence in their ability to lead and witness to Jesus, our Lord and Saviour. **Lord, hear us.**
